To play this Marvel trivia game, get a group of friends together and decide which player is going to be the "game head." This is the player who is going to read the trivia questions to the group. You can name this person a fun nickname, like The Incredible Hulk.

This player is going to read each Marvel trivia question to the group. Every other player should have a piece of paper and a pen/pencil to write down their answers. At the end of their 20 or 50 questions, the player with the most correct answers wins.

It's possible to play in multiple rounds, too. Where three rounds are played and the person who wins the most rounds wins the entire game.
