Here's how to play. Inform each child that the trivia game is about to take place. Ensure that each child has a piece of paper and a pencil. Tell them the game rules. After each trivia question is presented to the group, a correct answer earns one point.

The player with the most points at the end of 25 or 50 questions is the winner.
